Order of the Arrow Representative

Job Description: The Order of the Arrow Troop Representative is a youth liaison serving between the local OA lodge and his troop. In his troop, he serves as a communication and programmatic link to the Arrowmen and adult leaders and who are not presently members of the Order.

- Reports to: **Scoutmaster**
- Minimum Rank: **First Class and Arrowman**
- Minimum Time in Troop: **1 yr**
- Prerequisite Offices: **None**
- Appointed by: **Scoutmaster**
- Term/Limitations: **6 months/no limitations**

OA Representative Duties:

- Serves as a communication link between the lodge and the troop.
- Encourages year round and resident camping in the troop.
- Encourages older Scout participation in high adventure programs.
- Encourages Scouts to actively participate in community service projects.
- Assists with leadership skills training in the troop.
- Encourages Arrowmen to assume leadership positions in the troop.
- Encourages Arrowmen in the troop to be active participants in the lodge activities and to seal their membership in the Order by becoming Brotherhood members.
- Set a good example.
- Enthusiastically and correctly wears the Scout uniform.
- Lives by the Scout Oath and Law.
- Shows and helps develop Scout Spirit.
- Attends most Scout meetings and camping trips.
